What his brothers had no way of knowing in those early days was that God was going to work through all the dysfunction, envy, hate, jealousy, and favoritism to bring about a much greater purpose. A big plan. A God plan. A plan that would be used to save Joseph's entire family and even a nation from disaster.

Later Joseph said to his brothers, "You meant evil against me, but God meant it for good" (Genesis 50:20).

And while I am not comparing my life to Joseph's in scope, I do believe that God has done for me what He did for Joseph and so many others. He has worked through the good, the bad, and the ugly to perform His Kingdom purposes.

What is He saying to you for 2016? Take time to listen, to reflect, to ask Him. What dreams has He placed in your heart? Believe that He is doing more than you can see. Accept that He has a plan and it is a good one. No circumstance, no failure, no evil in the heart of others can prevail against His ultimate plans.
